

ACT PREP AT JESUIT

An ACT TEST PREPARATION COURSE is offered at Jesuit during the FALL, the SPRING, and SUMMER.

FALL 2008 ACT COURSE

LOCATION: Jesuit High School, rm. 231

DATES: SEPT. 6, 9, 11, 13, 16, 18, 20, 23, 30; OCT. 2, 4, 7, 9, 18. The total course runs for **14 classes, 35 total class hours** and ends 1 week before the Oct. 25 ACT).

TIMES: Saturdays (9 am – noon) & Tues. & Thurs. (4 – 6:00 pm.)

COST: \$325 (In case of cancellation, \$50 is non-refundable).

Registration is on a “first come, first served” basis. A registration coupon and the fee must be submitted for registration.

PREREQUISITES

The Preparation Course is intended primarily for Jesuit High School students, **but students from other high schools are welcome. Students will benefit from the course if they have completed at least English 2, Algebra 1, and Geometry.

During the course students are taught strategies for each of the five parts of the ACT, and they take FOUR full, past ACT tests.

The Jesuit ACT Course includes strategies and practice for the essay part of the ACT. All students write two ACT essays which are scored.

FAQ

1. When is the best time to take the ACT?

Students at Jesuit are encouraged to take the ACT no later than the end of their junior year. Some take it as early as the end of their sophomore year. Taking it at the end of the junior year allows a student time to retake it if he or she wants to get a higher score. At the end of the year a student will also have just completed another year of English and math, which will help on the ACT. **Some students also find it very helpful to take the ACT immediately after an ACT PREP course.**

2. Should my son / daughter take the ACT or the SAT?

The TOPS program in Louisiana accepts either the ACT or the SAT. Colleges and universities in Louisiana accept the ACT or the SAT for college entrance. Most colleges or universities outside Louisiana accept either the ACT or the

SAT for admission; students should check each college's admission requirements. It may be beneficial for a student to take both tests in order to discover on which test he or she does better.

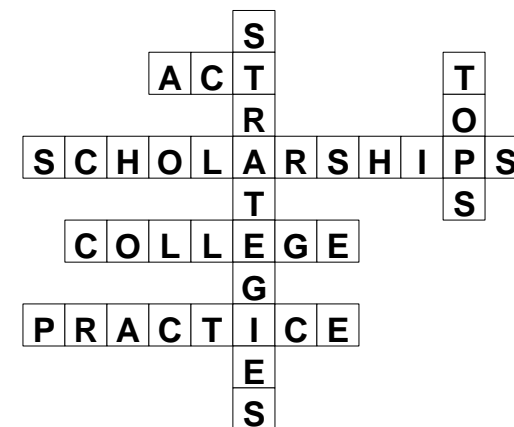
