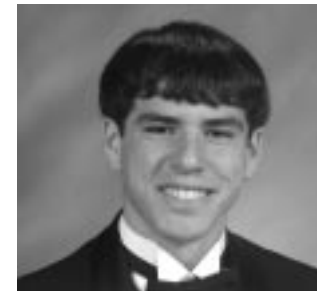

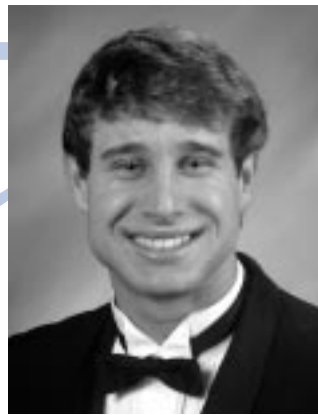

The National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) recognized 31 Jesuit High School seniors as Semi-finalists in the annual *Merit Scholarship Competition*. One Jesuit senior, Samuel A. Just, turned in a perfect test score of 240. No other high school in Louisiana boasted as many Semi-finalists as these 31 seniors who represent the Class of 2006. This year's cutoff score of 212 was two points higher than last year's, making it even more difficult to achieve National Merit Semi-finalist status. The mean score of our honorees was 222, a reflection of the academic excellence for which Jesuit is traditionally renowned. The faculty and administration of Jesuit High School extend their congratulations to each student on his significant achievement.

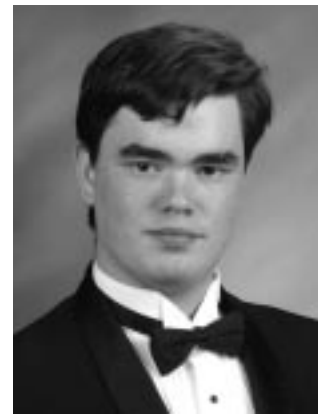
