

SAT/ PSAT PREP AT JESUIT

An SAT/PSAT PREPARATION COURSE is offered at Jesuit in the FALL, SPRING, and SUMMER.

FALL 2008 SAT/PSAT COURSE

LOCATION: Jesuit, Rm. 231

DATES: Aug. 16, 20, 23, 25, 27; Sept. 3, 6, 10, 13, 15, 17, 22, 24, 27 (The course runs for a total of **14 classes, 36 total class hours**).

TIMES: Saturdays (9am – noon.) & Mon. & Wed. (4 – 6 pm.)

COST: \$325 (In case of cancellation, \$50 is non-refundable).

Registration is on a “first come, first served” basis. A registration coupon and the fee must be submitted for registration.

PREREQUISITES

The SAT Prep Course is intended primarily for Jesuit students, but students **from other high schools are welcome. In the fall SAT/PSAT Course, however, space for non-Jesuit students is limited.** Students from Dominican, Mount Carmel, Ursuline, Sacred Heart, Ben Franklin, McGehee, Catholic High of Baton Rouge, St. Joseph’s Academy of Baton Rouge, St. Paul’s, St. Paul’s, Mandeville High, and Br. Martin have taken the course.

Students will benefit the most from the course if they have completed at least English 2, Algebra 1, and Geometry.

During the course students are taught strategies for each part of the SAT/PSAT, and they take FOUR full SAT and/or PSAT tests.

The Jesuit SAT/PSAT Course includes strategies and practice for the essay part of the SAT. All students write two SAT essays which are scored.

FAQ

1. When is the best time to take the SAT? PSAT?

Students at Jesuit are encouraged to take the SAT no later than the end of their junior year. Taking it at the end of the junior year allows a student time to retake it if he or she wants to get a higher score. All Jesuit students take the PSAT for the National Merit Competition at very beginning of their junior year. The PSAT is very nearly a mini-SAT. Preparation for the SAT is also preparation for the PSAT.

2. Should my son / daughter take the ACT or the SAT?

The TOPS program in Louisiana accepts either the ACT or the SAT. Colleges and universities in Louisiana accept the ACT or the SAT for college entrance. Most colleges or universities outside Louisiana also accept either the ACT or the SAT for admission; students should check each college's admission requirements. It may be beneficial for a student to take both tests in order to discover on which test he or she does better.

3. Why do more students in Louisiana take the ACT and not the SAT? Custom and misinformation. Both are skills tests; both may be used for TOPS and admission to any Louisiana college or university.

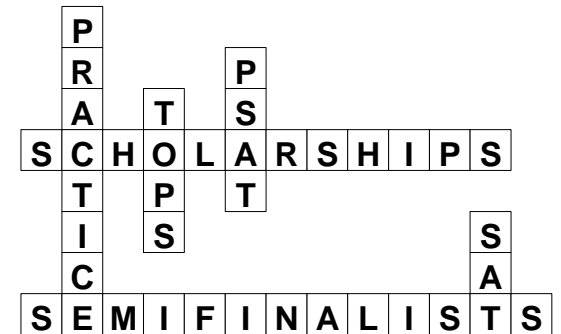
