

## **2009 USED BOOK SALES INFORMATION**

We are pleased to announce that the used book sale for non-state textbooks will be held on Wednesday, August 5<sup>th</sup> on the third floor. Sale hours are 8 a.m. – 2 p.m.

The used book sale, manned by parent volunteers, affords an opportunity for Jesuit families to sell old books and save money on their son's books for next year.

Volunteer parents who work the sale and Jesuit High School are not responsible for any checks/books that may be lost or misplaced.

Participation in this book sale is strictly voluntary. Required books on your son's book list may be purchased from the school during class-level book sales in August 2009.

### **USED BOOK DROP OFF PROCEDURE**

A volunteer will be available to accept used books at the following times:

May 4 – 7 (Senior Exams) – 9am – 11:30am in Room 329

May 18 – 21 (Underclass Exams) – 9am – 11:30 in Room 329

August 4 - 9am – 12:00 in Room 329

**An ENVELOPE with the following PRINTED information must be included in each book that is dropped off for sale:**

Name of book (Algebra I, Spanish III, etc.)

Name of student

Phone number of student

**Each BOOK turned in should have the student's name printed inside the book with the current school year.** This procedure helps keep the proper book matched to the proper envelope.

Books that **will not** be accepted for sale:

Books that will not be used by Jesuit next year (a listing will be posted)

Workbooks, Novels

SAT books; PSAT, ACT, SAT prep course books

Writing Handbook

State books

## **USED BOOK SALE PROCEDURES**

The sale of non-state textbooks will be held on Wednesday, August 5 starting at 8 a.m.

Books will be priced at 50% of original cost of book.

You will need your son's book list to purchase books. If you did not receive the list in the mail, a duplicate list will be available at the book sale.

You do not need to come to the used book sale for state books. State books are marked on the book list and will be posted the day of the sale.

Using the student's book list for the 2009-2010 school year, choose the books needed and proceed to the checkout area.

Payment is made by **CHECK ONLY** – **A SEPARATE CHECK** must be made for **EACH BOOK** purchased. Checks must be made out to "Cash." A cashier will place checks directly into envelopes. Please do not put your payment in envelope until a cashier has verified the payment.

Books not picked up by August 6 will become the property of the school.

Book sale volunteers and Jesuit High School are not responsible for any books that have been lost/misplaced.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Books may not be returned, so be sure you have purchased the correct book. (Check the course number on your son's book list). Volunteers will be available during the sale to help you.

We cannot guarantee that all the books on your son's book list will be available at the sale – some may be state books; others may be a new series of books.

Books not sold/picked up by August 6 will be donated the school and cannot be returned to the original owners.

Money not picked up by August 21 will be donated to the school.

Book sale volunteers and Jesuit High School are not responsible for checks/books that are lost/misplaced.

The used book sale is run by parent volunteers. Your patience is appreciated and your suggestions for next year's sale are welcomed.
