

## JHS Vocabulary Card Format

### Format for Vocabulary Cards

- Use 3x5 index cards, ruled on one side.
- On the un-ruled side, neatly write the word in the center of the card.
- In the top left corner, identify the card by writing the quiz number (from 1-6), a hyphen, and the number of the word (from 1-20). For example, the first word from the first quiz would be 1-1; the twelfth word from the fourth quiz would be 4-12.
- In the top right corner of the first card, write your full name. Write your initials in the same location on each consecutive card.
- On the ruled side, write the word's part of speech on the left side of the top line.
- Skip a line.
- Write the **full definition** from the SAT book.
- Skip a line.
- Write an example sentence. Your teacher will instruct you whether to compose your own original sentence of ten (10) words or more or to copy the example sentence from the SAT book.
