Criteria:

1. Demonstrated excellence/achievement in his professional career
2. Demonstrated leadership in some aspect of his life – professional, civic, spiritual, social, etc.
3. Is a representative Blue Jay, one whose life has reflected the mission of his alma mater to form men of faith and men for others
4. Has remained connected to his alma mater through the years

Eligibility:

- The AOY must be a graduate of Jesuit High School of New Orleans.
- He must have graduated from Jesuit at least 20 years ago.
- Members of the Society of Jesus are not eligible.
- Generally, the award is not presented posthumously.
